Supervision:

- Executes work under direct supervision 10% of the time; works independently setting work schedule priorities 90% of the time.
- Does not supervise others.

Primary Purpose:

Responsible for creating, testing and maintaining the computer database system, working closely with database administrators to easily use and access data.

Essential Responsibilities:

- Identify, access and document functional requirements, risks and mitigation plans
- Create security plans and measures to ensure database integrity
- Document technical requirements and design specification to support all areas of data management
- Develop and implement database solutions aligned with business strategy
- Maintain database performance by identifying and resolving production problems
- Manage big data challenges including storage, access, analysis, reporting and information privacy
- Problem solve and provide support to users
- Conduct training for users as needed
- Applies lean tools and thinking to identify and eliminate waste
- Follows and applies standard work and work instructions

Occasional Work:

- Occasional overnight travel to other distribution centers or for outside meetings/ training as needed.
- Training/ participation in a Total Quality Management (TQM) and Lean environment.
- Off-hours or weekend work as needed
- On-call pager rotation as required.

Safety Responsibility:

This position assumes responsibility for the workplace safety of self and co-workers, and for the safety conditions of the work location, exercises and promotes safe behaviors and shows unyielding support of programs, rules and policies regarding safety.
