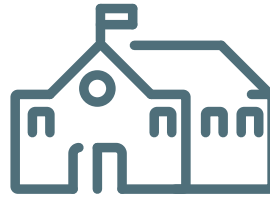
**GOALS:** To be the fastest growing U.S. metropolitan area for immigration by 2025, and add 25,000 foreign born to the region 2016 - 2025
